INTRODUCTION

Master of Science in Counselling is offered by the Faculty of Cognitive Sciences and Human Development and is aimed to produce registered counsellors with:

The curriculum is aligned with the Standards and Requirements of Training for Counsellors (2011) as set by the Lembaga Kaunselor (Malaysia).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Bachelor's Degree with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 or any equivalent, from a university recognized by the Senate and MQA; or
- A Bachelor's Degree or equivalent with a CGPA less than 2.50, from a university recognized by the Senate and MQA, may be qualified subject to a minimum of 5 years working experiences in the relevant field; and
- Candidates must pass the interview or equivalent assessment conducted by the Faculty of Cognitive Sciences and Human Development
- For international students, a minimum IELTS score of 4.5 or its equivalent (e.g. MUET Band 3; TOEFL iBT 33; TOEFL Essential (Online) 6.5, Pearson Test of English 43, Cambridge English Qualifications and Tests 147)* is required.
