INTRODUCTION

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Bachelor's Degree in the field or related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 or equivalent, as accepted by the Senate; or
- A Bachelor's Degree in the field or related fields not meeting a CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to at least five (5) years of working experience in related field
- For international students, a minimum IELTS score of 5.0 or its equivalent (e.g. MUET Band 3; TOEFL-525; TOEFL Computer Test-196, TOEFL Internet Test 69-70) is required.
