- For international students, a minimum IELTS score of 4.5 or its equivalent (e.g. MUET Band 3; TOEFL iBT 33; TOEFL Essential (Online) 6.5, Pearson Test of English 43, Cambridge English Qualifications and Tests 147)\* is required.
